
The heart constantly pumps blood to provide oxygen and nutrition to the body.

It receives its own supply of nourished blood from a network of coronary arteries.

The heart beats about 100,000 times a day.

Heart Attack happens in the heart when heart muscle is starved of oxygen-rich blood due to blockage in the artery supplying blood to it.

Stroke happens in the brain when it is starved of blood due to clot in the artery supplying blood to it.

Heart Disease Risk Factors


